BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The City of Bowling Green shall join and become a member of Buckeye Ohio Risk Management Association (BORMA) effective immediately upon passage. The City of Bowling Green understands that, as a member of BORMA, it will have access to all programs, services, and benefits that are available to other members under the current governing documents of BORMA.

SECTION 2: The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents on behalf of the City of Bowling Green and to do all other things necessary and consistent with this resolution to effectuate its purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public or otherwise in compliance with all legal requirements.

RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BUCKEYE OHIO RISK MANAGEMENT AGENCY (BORMA)

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green is a member of the Buckeye Ohio Risk Management Agency (BORMA); and

WHEREAS, as a member of BORMA, this legislative body is required to appoint one (1) person to represent the City of Bowling Green on the Board of Directors of BORMA and shall appoint one (1) person to serve as an alternate representative when the initial representative is unable to carry out that representative's duties.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Finance Director is hereby appointed to serve as the representative of the City of Bowling Green on the BORMA Board of Directors.

SECTION 2: The Personnel Director is hereby appointed to serve as the alternate representative of the City of Bowling Green on the BORMA Board of Directors when the initial representative appointed in Section 1 of this resolution is unable to carryout his/her duties.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public or otherwise in compliance with all legal requirements.



**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7906 BY
AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 39.06(4)
CONCERNING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 7906 adopting Chapter 39 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended with respect only to Section 39.06(4) thereof in its entirety as follows:

SECTION 39.06 GENERAL EXCEPTIONS

(4) Nothing in this chapter shall bar a fraternal organization from giving preference to members of such fraternal organization or from making such selection as is calculated by such organization to promote the aims, purposes, or fraternal principals for which it is established or maintained. This chapter shall not apply to any religious corporation, organization, or association, **nor shall it apply to the Bowling Green Christian Academy or St. Aloysius School.** The application and enforcement of the protections created herein are limited solely to the terms of this chapter and such terms shall not create nor enhance protected class status for any other purpose including public and private affirmative action program eligibility. The term "affirmative action program" shall include any program administered by any private or public entity for the purpose of providing preferential treatment for those in a protected class. Any practice which has a discriminatory effect and which would be otherwise prohibited by this chapter shall not be deemed unlawful if it can be established that such practice is not intentionally devised or operated to contravene the prohibitions of this chapter and can be justified by business necessity. Under this chapter, a "business necessity" exception is applicable only in each individual case where it can be proved by a respondent that, without such exception, such business cannot be conducted; a "business necessity" exemption cannot be justified by the factors of increased costs to business, business efficiency, the comparative characterizations of one group as opposed to another, and the preferences of co-workers, employers, customers or any other person.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order that the amendments which are subject of this measure be in effect at the time of the effective date of the entire Chapter 39 recently adopted by the Electors of the City of Bowling Green, and thereby protect the public health, safety, and well-being of our citizens.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
