ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS TO PERFORM SEWER RELINING AND SEWER REPLACEMENT WORK IN THE 200 AND 300 BLOCKS OF EAST WOOSTER STREET AS PART OF THE EAST WOOSTER STREET REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Utilities Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for sewer relining and sewer replacement work in the 200 and 300 blocks of East Wooster Street as part of the East Wooster Street redevelopment project.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order that the project can be completed in a timely manner during the appropriate portion of the 2010 construction season, as the rest and remainder of the project has been scheduled and the need for sewer relining and replacement has recently come to light. The immediate effectiveness of this measure will allow the project to be completed on time and with the appropriate sewer service in place, thereby protecting the public health, safety, and well-being of our citizens.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 2379, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
