


Temporary Signs (Non-Residential)

Free Standing Temporary Signs and Banners are 2 types of temporary signs regulated within the City of Bowling Green.



Temporary signs generally require a permit from the Planning Department.



Free-Standing Temporary Signs

May be erected for special events, short-term events by commercial or institutional establishments, under the following regulations:

1. Must be non-illuminated.
2. Cannot interfere with visibility of pedestrians or car traffic.
3. Cannot exceed 6' in height.
4. Must be 10' from the right-of-way.
5. Cannot exceed 16 square feet in size.
6. Permitted 1 time per calendar year for a 30 day period, maximum.
7. A \$5 permit is required, with a sketch showing the proposed location.

Banners

Must be flush-mounted to a building face any place between the sidewalk elevation and the building roof line. Permitted no more than 4 times per calendar year at any one location (You could have 4 banners up at the same time for 30 maximum days, 3 banners for 40 maximum days, 2 banners for 60 maximum days or 1 banner for 120 maximum days or you could have 1 banner up for 30 days and decide to put one up at a later date for another 30 days). No permit required. The maximum size permitted is 16 square feet.

Temporary Signs Regulated by Municipal Administrator / Safety Director

The Municipal Administrator can issue permits for the following types of signs, as regulated in Chapter 115.01:

1. Inflatable signs at commercial or industrial sites.
2. A-Frame signs on public sidewalks in the B-3 District.
3. Temporary signs in the public right-of-way.
