Projects Accomplished

- Purchased equipment for a variety of youth, recreational and nature activities.
- Acquired the Bordner Meadow which is now the heart of the Wintergarden/St. John's Nature Preserve.
- Added nearly 7 adjacent acres named the Twyman Woods to the Wintergarden/St. John's Nature Preserve.
- Purchased signage and other improvements for Wintergarden/St. John's Nature Preserve.
- Raised over \$700,000 to build Simpson Garden Park and fund an endowment.
- Purchased 19.6 acres now known as Tucker Woods through the \$480,000 Save the Woods campaign.
- Raised over \$33,000 toward land for athletic fields.
- Currently raising \$300,000 to renovate the Nature Center.
