PROJECT SUMMARY

The City of Bowling Green has contracted with Geddis Paving & Excavating, Inc., for intersection improvements on South Main Street at Gypsy Lane Road. East Gypsy Lane Road will be widened to install a turn lane and then the entire intersection will be repaved.

East Gypsy Lane will be completely closed to traffic from South Main to 800' East from July 18, 2016 to August 8, 2016.

The project is scheduled to begin July 18, 2016 and should be completed by September 11, 2016 weather permitting.

DRIVEWAY/BUSINESS ACCESS

The Contractor is obligated to maintain access to driveways and businesses within the construction zone. However, certain construction operations may result in a temporary disruption to access.

One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on South Main Street. East Gypsy Lane Road will be closed to through traffic for 21 calendar days as of July 18, 2016. If you are a resident and see a sign that reads “**ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC**”, you **are permitted** to drive around the sign with caution. If the road is completely barricaded or a sign reads “**ROAD CLOSED**”, you are **not permitted** to drive around the sign.

For your safety and the safety of the workers, please use caution when entering the construction zone. If you have doubts about entering a construction area, please stop and ask.

TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

Trash and recycling collection will continue on your regular day. Please note, however, that it will likely be picked up first thing in the morning before construction begins. Therefore, it is recommended that you have your trash and recycling to the curb by 6:30 am.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

It may be necessary to impose parking restrictions on side streets during the project. Please be aware of signage in the area outlining the times and dates of parking restrictions. Violators of the parking restrictions will be subject to ticketing or may be towed.
