# ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING CERTAIN PROPERTIES IN INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY PARK TO BOWLING GREEN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN LIEU OF DUES TO FACILITATE A DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a deed for the properties in Innovative Technology Park, Plat 1, in the City of Bowling Green, Wood County, Ohio, as depicted on the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten herein, to Bowling Green Economic Development, formerly known as The Bowling Green Community Development Foundation, in lieu of the payment of dues to facilitate an economic development project that will enhance the City and create numerous jobs for our citizens.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is a prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order to facilitate the economic development project that will enhance the Innovative Technology Park owned by the City, and will enhance the City in general, and will provide for jobs for our citizens. In order to meet timelines as established by the proposed end user, this ordinance must take effect at the earliest time possible, so as to protect the public health, safety, and well-being of our citizens.
