ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, Wood County, Ohio (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon of award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision's participation in the road salt contract; and
d. The Political Subdivision's electronic order for sodium chloride (road salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its electronically submitted salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
g. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, April 29, 2022 by 5:00 p.m. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT salt contract:

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC SERVICES DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE CATASTROPHIC SNOWFALL PROGRAM FOR STATE FISCAL YEARS 2022 AND 2023; AND GIVING CONSENT OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN FOR ODOT TO PROVIDE SECONDARY SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL AND TO USE SNOW AND ICE CONTROL MATERIAL ON ROADS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION IN THE EVENT OF 16 OR MORE INCHES OF SNOWFALL WITHIN A 24-HOUR PERIOD

WHEREAS, Section 755.40 of Amended Substitute House Bill Number 74 provides for the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to establish a Catastrophic Snowfall Program during State fiscal years 2022 and 2023 to provide supplemental snow removal aid to counties, municipal corporations or townships that receive sixteen or more inches of snow in a twenty-four-hour period and that request aid under the Program; and

WHEREAS, ODOT has established a Catastrophic Snowfall Program that requires an application and consent legislation prior to performing any snow removal requested under this Program; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Bowling Green, desires to submit an application to ODOT for the Catastrophic Snowfall Program and provide consent for ODOT to provide supplemental snow and ice removal and apply snow and ice control material on roads within the jurisdiction of the City of Bowling Green in the event sixteen or more inches of snow falls in a twenty-four-hour period; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance shall not relieve or discharge the City of Bowling Green from any claim or claims of any nature arising from, or growing out of, the work by ODOT under this Program on the roads within this jurisdiction, and the City of Bowling Green shall save ODOT and the State of Ohio harmless from any and all such claims.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Bowling Green, County of Wood, and State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: It is hereby declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said City of Bowling Green be, and such consent is hereby given to ODOT for said Department to provide supplemental snow and ice removal and apply snow and ice control material on roads within the jurisdiction of the City of Bowling Green in the event sixteen or more inches of snow falls in a twenty-four-hour period in accordance with the standard practices of the Ohio Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2: That the City of Bowling Green Public Services Director is authorized to submit an application to the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Catastrophic Snowfall Program for State fiscal years 2022 and 2023 and to work with the ODOT for supplemental snow removal aid in the event sixteen or more inches of snow falls in a twenty-four-hour period.

SECTION 3: That the City of Bowling Green hereby saves ODOT and the State of Ohio harmless from any and all claims of any nature arising from, or growing out of, the work by ODOT under the Catastrophic Snowfall Program.

SECTION 4: That the Clerk is hereby directed to furnish the Director of Transportation with a certified copy of this ordinance immediately upon execution.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING THE 2022 S-14 SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the fourteenth (14th) supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted since the recodification of the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or reference sections of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the law of the State of Ohio; and

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT PUMPS FOR THE ATAD PROCESS AT THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:
