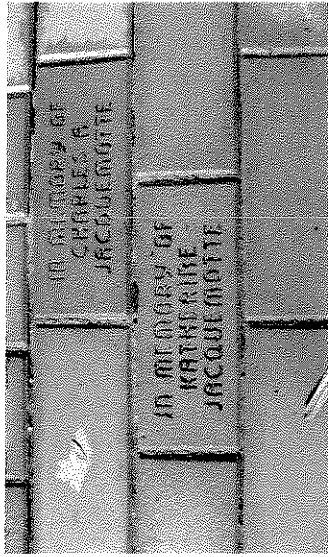


What are the Memorial Walkways?

The walkways are a gift from families and friends to the people who visit Simpson Garden Park. Bricks are donated in honor or in memory of a loved one or to commemorate a special occasion. Brick donations can be made throughout the year and engraving takes place on a quarterly basis.

Memorial Bricks

Bricks are 4" x 8" and can hold 3 lines of engraving with 12 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation).



Donations

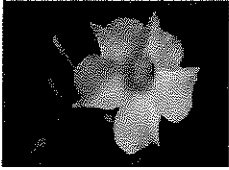

What is Simpson Garden Park?

Simpson Garden Park, the first of its kind in Northwest Ohio, began development in 2000 thanks to a generous bequest from Violet and Newt Simpson and a capital campaign that raised over \$700,000. Today the 11 acre garden includes a Shade garden, Children's garden, Sensory garden, Healing garden and Upland garden. Hardscapes include bridges and waterfalls, sculptures and an amphitheatre. The gardens have played host to many community programs and special events.
