A. First Reading

Ordinance providing supplemental appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012.

Ordinance authorizing the Utilities Director to enter into an agreement with Interstate Gas Supply to provide a fixed price option to municipal natural gas aggregation customers, and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance authorizing the Utilities Director to bind the City in participating in American Municipal Power, Inc. Joint Purchasing Alliance Program.

Ordinance amending and adopting Sections 150.03, 150.35, 150.37, 150.45, and 150.59 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, by adding "indoor sports training facility" provisions.

B. Second Reading

- 8172 Ordinance to provide for the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$6,750,000 for the purpose of refunding at a lower interest cost certain of the City's outstanding various purpose improvement bonds, Series 2004, dated as of May 6, 2004, and declaring an emergency.
