RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF (A) PROPOSAL(S) WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GRANTS THROUGH THE US DOT FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA), AS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL TRANSIT LAWS, AS CODIFIED, 49 USC SECTION 5311, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR OTHER THAN URBANIZED AREAS AND FUNDS AVAILABLE FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT PROGRAM, EXECUTING A CONTRACT/GRANT FOR THE FY 2013 OHIO ELDERLY AND DISABLED TRANSIT FARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, AND EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UPON GRANT PROPOSAL AND/OR APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a public transportation program;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the proposer, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of a proposal for assistance under 49 USC Section 5311 the proposer give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Proposer that disadvantaged business enterprise be used to the fullest extent possible in connection with this/these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and submit (a) proposal(s) on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects pursuant to 49 USC Section 5311 and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file with such proposal and assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal for the program of projects submitted to FTA.

SECTION 4: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection to any procurement made as part of the project.

SECTION 5: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of operating and capital assistance projects.

SECTION 6: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is hereby authorized to execute a contract/grant for the FY 2013 Ohio Elderly and Disabled Transit Fare Assistance Program and execute and file any assurances or any other documentation required by the Ohio Department of Transportation on behalf of the city of Bowling Green, Ohio.

SECTION 7: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.



**ORDINANCE FOR CLEANING OF STREETS
BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green has for many years financed the cleaning of its streets by special assessment levied on the lots and lands in Bowling Green, Ohio, by a percentage of the tax valuation of the property assessed, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to continue to have the cleaning of streets in the City of Bowling Green financed by special assessments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:


SECTION 1: That the cost and expense of cleaning the streets, alleys, lanes, squares, and public places in the City be paid for by special assessments levied upon non-tax exempt lots and lands within said City of Bowling Green, Ohio.

SECTION 2: Said special assessment shall be based upon a percentage of the tax valuation of all non-tax exempt lots and lands within the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, to produce the sum of \$425,000.00 and shall be payable annually in two equal installments during the period of the assessment; that said assessments are hereby levied on all non-tax exempt lots and lands in the City of Bowling Green for the year 2012. The City Finance Director is authorized and directed to certify the same to the County Auditor of Wood County, Ohio, to be collected as other taxes are collected and paid.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:


SECTION 1: That the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to sell and/or otherwise dispose of the following vehicle as it is not needed for municipal purposes:


