ORDINANCE CERTIFYING UNPAID COST OF WEED MOWING TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR PLACEMENT ON THE TAX DUPLICATE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and Ohio Revised Code Section 701.05 grant assessment authority; and

WHEREAS, Codified Ordinances provide notification to property owners to mow weeds on premises within the City; and

WHEREAS, the property owners were notified to have weeds moved and failed to timely remove the same requiring the City to remove the same at the cost of the City; and

WHEREAS, the property owners upon demand have refused to reimburse the City of Bowling Green for the cost of such services;

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has certified such costs to the Council for certification to the Wood County Auditor to place on the tax duplicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the amounts be certified to the Wood County Auditor for the parcels represented on the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof and be placed on the tax duplicate for the year 2014.

SECTION 1: That Section 73.15(B) is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

73.15 SPEED LIMITS

(16) Twenty-five miles per hour on Conneaut Avenue from 527 feet west of the Conneaut/Haskins intersection to Grove Street pursuant to R.C. 4511.21(J).

SECTION 2: All other existing portions of Section 73.15(B) remain unchanged.

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 30.67 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, CONCERNING SPECIAL DUTY FOR POLICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 30.67 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, be amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 30.67 SPECIAL DUTY FOR POLICE

The Safety Director is authorized and directed to enter into written agreements with public or private organizations for the assignment of police officers to special police duty with those organizations where, in the opinion of the Safety Director and the Chief of Police, this duty serves the purpose of public safety, traffic control, and public welfare. The written agreements shall be approved by the Safety Director and city attorney, and shall contain, among others, the following provisions.

(A) The police officer shall be specifically assigned to duty by and under the control of the Chief of Police, and shall at all times be considered as being on official police duty.

(B) The police officer may or may not be in full uniform depending upon the nature of the assignment.

(C) The city will be reimbursed by the public or private organization requesting the services at a rate determined by the Safety Director.

(D) The duties shall be restricted to the limits of the city.

(E) The city will agree to furnish manpower only to the extent of its availability.

(F) The agreement shall be subject to cancellation by either party within 30 days.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the continuity of special duty police assignments, thereby protecting the public peace, health and safety of our citizens.
