RESOLUTION OF THE CITY'S INTENT TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO POTENTIALLY WITHDRAW FROM THE BORMA PROPERTY AND CASUALTY POOL AND FROM PERC

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green, Ohio (hereinafter "the City") is currently a member of the Buckeye Ohio Risk Management Association (hereinafter "BORMA"), a self-insurance property and casualty pool for municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City's Finance Director is the representative of the City of said pool;

WHEREAS, as a member of the BORMA property and casualty pool, the City, either individually or by reason of being a member of the "Pool", is also a member of a nonprofit association known as Public Entity Risk Consortium (hereinafter "PERC"); and

WHEREAS, timely notice is required of the City's intent to withdraw from BORMA property and casualty pool as well as from PERC.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, hereby authorizes the City's Finance Director to provide timely notice of potential withdrawal, on the City's behalf, from the BORMA property and casualty pool in order to perfect said withdrawal by the end of the policy year, which is November 30, 2012.

SECTION 2: That the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, hereby authorizes the City's Finance Director to provide timely notice of potential withdrawal, on the City's behalf, from PERC in order to perfect said withdrawal by the end of the policy year, which is November 30, 2012.

SECTION 3: That the City reserve any rights to any and all interests it may have in the self-insurance funds or any other funds of both BORMA property and casualty pool, and PERC.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in open meetings of the City Council.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 114.08(B) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING
APPLICATION FOR (TAXICAB) DRIVER'S LICENSE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 114.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 114.08 APPLICATION FOR DRIVER'S LICENSE

(B) Each applicant shall furnish a recent photograph, approximately three inches square, and fingerprints in duplicate. At the time the application is filed, the applicant shall have in his or her possession and show to the Board an Ohio driver license which is not revoked, and shall pay to the Board the sum of \$5. Before approval is given by the Taxicab Review Board, the applicant shall provide a certificate from a ~~reputable~~ physician of ~~the city~~ **licensed by the State of Ohio Medical Board** certifying that in his or her opinion the applicant is not afflicted with any disease or infirmity which might make the applicant an unsafe or unsatisfactory driver.

SECTION 2: All other portions of Section 114.08 remain unchanged.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.







ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF AN AQUATIC FACILITY AT CITY PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the demolition and construction of an aquatic facility located in City Park in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Municipal Administrator.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is to allow for the immediate demolition of the current pool facility at the end of the current pool season and the beginning of the construction of the new facility in order to be operational by the following pool season, thereby protecting the public peace, safety and well-being of the citizens.

**ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING THE
2012 S-4 SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
FOR THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the fourth supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted since the recodification of the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make reference to sections of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the law of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the fourth supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Such supplement shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and ordered to insert such supplement into the copy of the Code of Ordinances kept on file in the Office of the Clerk.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
