

ORDINANCE DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THERMAL PROCESS SYSTEMS, INC. OF CROWN POINT, INDIANA, FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIVE REPLACEMENT AUTO THERMAL THERMOPHILIC AEROBIC DIGESTION PUMPS FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That a real and present emergency is declared and the Utilities Director is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Thermal Process Systems, Inc. of Crown Point, Indiana, for the purchase of five replacement auto thermal thermophilic aerobic digestion pumps for the Water Pollution Control Facility without advertising for bids.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary as the Water Pollution Facility is in immediate need for one auto thermal thermophilic aerobic digestion pump for replacement, and has four unique pump sizes that require lead time in order to replace, and said equipment is immediately necessary to meet the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination system permit, and thereby protect the public health, safety and well-being of our citizens.
