ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS AND/OR PARTICIPATE IN STATE OF OHIO PURCHASING PROGRAMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT AS WELL AS THE TRADE-IN OR OUTRIGHT SALE OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT BEING REPLACED AND/OR NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Municipal Administrator is authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of vehicles and equipment as detailed below, or in the alternative, to participate in the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program or the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program:

DIVISION	DESCRIPTION
Public Works	Street Sweeper
	Mini-excavator
Police	Four (4) Police Cruisers
Parks and Recreation	Exercise Equipment

Section 2: That the Municipal Administrator is also authorized to trade or outright sell or otherwise dispose of vehicles and equipment that are no longer needed for municipal purposes.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The emergency is necessary in order to meet deadlines imposed by the vehicle and equipment manufacturers and to allow the City to act in an expeditious manner to meet imposed deadlines by state purchasing programs, thereby protecting the public health, safety, and well-being of the citizens of Bowling Green.
