RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF (A) PROPOSAL(S) AND/OR (AN) APPLICATION(S) WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GRANTS THROUGH THE US DOT FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA), AS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL TRANSIT LAWS, AS CODIFIED, 49 USC SECTION 5311, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR OTHER THAN URBANIZED AREAS AND FUNDS AVAILABLE FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT PROGRAM, EXECUTING A CONTRACT/GRANT FOR THE FY 2016 OHIO ELDERLY AND DISABLED TRANSIT FARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, AND EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UPON GRANT PROPOSAL AND/OR APPLICATION APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a public transportation program;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the proposer, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of a proposal for assistance under 49 USC Section 5311 the proposer give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprise be used to the fullest extent possible in connection with this/these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and submit (a) proposal(s) and/or application(s) on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects pursuant to 49 USC Section 5311 and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file with such proposal(s) and/or application(s) and assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal and/or application for the program of projects submitted to FTA.

SECTION 4: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection to any procurement made as part of the project.

SECTION 5: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of operating and capital assistance projects.

SECTION 6: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is hereby authorized to execute a contract/grant for the FY 2016 Ohio Elderly and Disabled Transit Fare Assistance Program and execute and file any assurances or any other documentation required by the Ohio Department of Transportation on behalf of the city of Bowling Green, Ohio.



RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS SUPPORT OF THE COMPLETE STREETS INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, Complete Streets are designed and operated to assure safety and accessibility for all the users of our roads, trails and transit systems, including pedestrian, bicyclists, transit riders, motorists, commercial and emergency vehicles and for people of all ages and of all abilities; and

WHEREAS, Complete Streets reduce congestion by providing safe travel choices that encourage non-motorized transportation options, increasing the overall capacity of the transportation network as well as decreasing consumer transportation costs; and

WHEREAS, Complete Streets support economic growth and community stability by providing accessible and efficient connections between home, school, work, recreation and retail destinations by improving the pedestrian and vehicular environments throughout communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green recognizes the importance of street infrastructure improvements and modifications such as sidewalks, crosswalks, shared-use paths, bicycle lanes, signage and accessible curb ramps that enable safe, convenient, and comfortable travel for all users; which improvements and modifications have been, are and will be components of the annual street resurfacing program and the annual sidewalk repair program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That this Council supports the Complete Streets initiative.

ORDINANCE CERTIFYING UNPAID COST OF SNOW REMOVAL TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR PLACEMENT ON THE TAX DUPLICATE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and Ohio Revised Code Section 701.05 grants assessment authority; and

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances requires property owners to clear snow on premises within 24 hours after the abatement of any storm during which such snow and ice may have accumulated; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director, for two weeks prior to January 1 of each year, published this determination in the newspaper of local circulation to notify property owners to regularly clean and keep all sidewalks abutting their premises free and clear of snow and ice within 24 hours after the abatement of any storm during which such snow and ice may have accumulated during the ensuing months of the year. Should any such snow and ice be found within the city, the Public Works Director may cause these sidewalks to be cleaned at the expense of the city;

WHEREAS, certain property owners failed to clear the snow within the required time requiring the City to remove the same at the cost of the City; and

WHEREAS, the property owners upon demand have refused to reimburse the City of Bowling Green for the cost of such services;

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has certified such costs to the Council for certification to the Wood County Auditor to place on the tax duplicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the amounts be certified to the Wood County Auditor for the parcels represented on the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof and be placed on the tax duplicate for the year 2015.



ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 33.07
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING PRE-EMPLOYMENT
MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND DRUG SCREENING,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING
GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 33.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of
Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

Section 33.07 Pre-employment Medical Examination & Drug Screening

(A) Each person, after receiving a conditional offer of employment to a
full-time or part-time, non- seasonal/non-temporary position with the city, shall be
required to undergo a medical examination. Medical examinations shall be
performed by a physician selected by the Personnel Director of the city. The
medical examiner shall report and certify to the Personnel Director whether the
person is physically and mentally capable of performing the services required of
the position, with or without a reasonable accommodation. If the medical examiner
certifies that the person is not physically or mentally capable of performing the
essential functions of the position to which he or she has been appointed, and it
can be shown that no reasonable accommodation is available that would enable
the individual to perform the essential functions of the job or that a requested
accommodation would impose an undue hardship on the city, then that person
would no longer be eligible for employment in that position with the city, and the
conditional offer of employment will be withdrawn.

(B) Each person, after receiving a conditional offer of employment to a
full-time or part-time, non- seasonal/non-temporary, **safety sensitive** position with
the city, shall be required to undergo a drug screening. Drug screenings shall be
performed at agencies and by persons who are trained and certified to perform
such tests. The agency that is responsible for performing the drug screenings
shall certify in writing to the city the results of the tests. If a drug screening
indicates a positive result, and there are grounds, as determined by the Personnel
Director, that a false positive reading was given, a second screening may be
authorized. If a false reading is not assumed or, in cases of a rescreening with a
positive result, the person will not be eligible for employment with the city in that
position and the conditional offer of employment will be withdrawn.

(C) The pre-employment medical examination and drug screening shall
be performed at the expense of the city.

(D) Each person, after receiving a conditional offer of employment to a
temporary **safety sensitive** position with the city, wherein driving city vehicles is a
job-related duty, shall also be required to undergo a drug screening.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure
necessary in order to provide consistency in the City's hiring practices, thereby
protecting the public peace, health and welfare of our citizens.
