**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDED  
B.G. TRANSIT DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING POLICY**

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green receives state and federal funding annually from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to provide public transportation to citizens; and

WHEREAS, a Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy is required for transit systems funded by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA); and

WHEREAS, an amended B.G. Transit Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy was last adopted by Council on November 4, 2013; and

WHEREAS, various minor amendments to the existing policy have been recommended by the Ohio Department of Transportation; the most significant reflecting the call-takers are now part of the testing pool.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: Following the need make recommended policy amendments, the Council does hereby approve the proposed amendments to the B.G. Transit Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PETITIONS FOR RENEWAL AND THE PLAN OF SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE BOWLING GREEN CENTRAL BUSINESS SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, INC.; APPROVING THE PROPERTIES OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN SAID PLAN OF SERVICES AND APPROVING THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN'S COOPERATIVE COST SHARE**

WHEREAS, Bowling Green City Council on March 15, 1999, in Resolution No. 3059 approved the creation of the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District Inc. and in the same Resolution authorized the properties of the Municipal Corporation abutting the streets described in the Articles of Incorporation be included in the District, and subsequently renewed the approval on July 5, 2005 in Resolution No. 3276 and on July 6, 2010 in Resolution No. 3432; and,

WHEREAS, the Bowling Green City Council on June 19, 2000, in Resolution No. 3115 approved the five year Plan of Services to be provided, approved the properties of the Municipal Corporation to be included in said plan and approved the City of Bowling Green's Cooperative Cost Share; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council has received petitions from property owners located in the district, as extended, who have initiated these petitions for renewal and requesting approval of the Plan of Services for the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council hereby finds the property owners per the signed petitions and the City per this Resolution represent approximately sixty-three percent (63%) of the front footage of the property located in the Special Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the Special Improvement District, as extended, is a valuable tool for economic development and a means of continuing to improve downtown Bowling Green,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Bowling Green, County of Wood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Petition for Renewal and Approval for the Plan of Services, including the cost of services to be provided by Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District, Inc. now on file with the Clerk of Bowling Green City Council and all of which are incorporated herein as Attachment A are hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to designate in writing that the properties of the Municipal Corporation abutting upon the streets described in petitions are included in the Plan of Services.

SECTION 3: The City's Cooperative Cost Share as provided for in the Plan of Services, in lieu of the front footage Special Assessment Cost, is hereby approved at \$34,916 annually for five years.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO IMPLEMENT THE PLAN OF SERVICES ADOPTED BY THE BOWLING GREEN CENTRAL BUSINESS SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, INC., AS APPROVED IN RESOLUTION NO. 3592 AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE SERVICES SET FORTH IN SAID PLAN UPON THE LOTS AND LANDS BENEFITING UNDER THE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bowling Green approved the renewal and the five-year Plan of Services submitted by petition and to be provided by the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District, Inc., pursuant to Resolution No. 3592 adopted \_\_\_\_\_; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan of Services calls for the provision of these services to the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District to be funded in part by special assessment; and,

WHEREAS, Sections 1710.02 and 1710.06 of the Ohio Revised Code authorize the participating political subdivision to levy a special assessment to pay for the costs of the services set forth in said Plan in that the services included in the Plan are deemed to be a special benefit to the property owners within the District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bowling Green, County of Wood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: It is declared necessary to implement the Plan of Services of the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District, Inc., (hereafter "SID") in the City of Bowling Green on Main Street, Wooster Street, Court Street, and Clough Street, and extended to include the area on East Wooster Street between Prospect Street and Summit Street, between certain termini as approved by the Council of the City of Bowling Green in Resolution No. 3592

SECTION 2: The Plan and estimate of cost of the services prepared by the SID providing for a total estimated cost of approximately \$137,870.00 per year for each of the five years of the Plan, as now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council as Attachment A to Resolution No. 3592 are approved, and the Plan shall be performed as shown therein. The lots and lands benefiting from and to be assessed for the services set forth in the Plan are shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3: The Council of the City of Bowling Green finds and determines that 1) the Plan of Services is conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and 2) the lots and lands to be assessed as described in Exhibit A hereof are specially benefited by the services set forth in the Plan in amounts equal to or greater than the assessed amounts.

SECTION 4: A portion of the costs of the services set forth in the Plan shall be assessed in proportion to the front footage of the lots and land benefiting under the Plan, said lots and lands being more specially described in Exhibit A. The Council of the City of Bowling Green hereby determines said assessment for such services to be \$12.00 per front foot of all such lots and lands as described in Exhibit A. It further provides,

however, that corner parcels, that is, for properties at Main Street and Wooster Street, Main Street and Court Street, and Main Street and Clough Street (east of Main Street) assessments will be applied only to the average of the combined sides of said parcel. The portion of the costs of the improvements to be paid by the City shall be as provided in the Plan and as approved by Resolution No. 3592

SECTION 5: That the Bowling Green Central Business Special Improvement District, Inc. is authorized and directed to prepare and file with Council in the office of the Clerk of Council an assessment report in accordance with the method of assessment provided for in this resolution. Such assessment report shall show the lots and lands assessed and the amount of assessment as to each. When the assessments have been so filed, the Clerk of Council shall cause notice of the adoption of this resolution and the filing of the estimated assessments to be served in the manner provided by law on the owners of all lots and lands to be assessed.

SECTION 6: That the assessment to be levied shall be paid in semi-annual installments and that the term of the assessments shall be for five (5) years from January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2020; provided, however, that the term of the assessment may be adjusted by the Board of Trustees of the SID as set forth in the Plan of Services approved in Resolution No. 3592; and further provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his/her option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty (30) days after passage of the assessing ordinance.

SECTION 7: The Clerk of Council is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Finance Director.

SECTION 8: The City does not intend to issue securities in anticipation of the levy or collection of the special assessments.

SECTION 9: The assessments to be levied and collected pursuant to this resolution may be levied and collected in whole or in part prior to the performance of the Plan.

SECTION 10: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 11: That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to post a copy of this Resolution as provided by law.

SECTION 12: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

WHEREAS, Mr. Fawcett's progressive leadership and long years of public service have been marked by hundreds of improvements throughout the city; although far too numerous to name, some noteworthy accomplishments are: Heritage 2000, expansion of the Fire Division including the addition of the West Side Fire Station, Bowling Green Municipal Court Building, construction of the Training and Community Center, major road improvement projects including East Wooster and North Main Street, significant expansions in the City Parks including Simpson Garden Park and a new Aquatics complex, and new industrial developments that have bolstered the economy of the City of Bowling Green ; and
