**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 152.20(H)(1) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING NUISANCE CONDITIONS PROHIBITED**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 152.20(H)(1) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**SECTION 152.20 NUISANCE CONDITIONS PROHIBITED**

(H) Allow any building or structure to become so dilapidated as to materially interfere with the peaceful enjoyment of adjacent property owners or endanger public health or safety; or

(1) The Safety Director or his/her designee, at his/her discretion, may deem a building or structure an endangerment of public health or safety. If a building or structure is so deemed, the Safety Director may cause the public health or safety concern to be mitigated at the owner's expense, the cost which shall be paid to the Finance Director. If said expense is not paid within 30 days of notice, the Finance Director may certify the amount to the County Auditor and request that the charge be added to the tax duplicate associated with the property.

SECTION 2: All other existing portions of Section 152.20 remain unchanged.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
