ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING CHANGES TO SECTIONS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING CITY FEES AND FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the fees listed below in Section 35.70 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, are hereby amended and adopted as follows:

SECTION 2: That Section 72.91(D) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 72.91 PERMIT APPLICATIONS. (PARADE)

(D) Fee. See Section 35.70 for parade permit fee information.

All other portions of Section 72.91 remain unchanged.

SECTION 3: That Section 75.32 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 75.32 LICENSE AND TAG FEES.

The license fee for the registration card and tag for each bicycle or motorized bicycle and shall be paid to the Police Chief at the time of the registration in accordance with the fees set forth in Section 35.70.

Upon application for a duplicate tag and/or registration card, in accordance with § 75.31, each owner shall pay to the Police Chief a fee for such duplicate tag and for such duplicate registration card in accordance with the fees set forth in Section 35.70. Upon recovery of a nonregistered bicycle which is stolen and later recovered by the police, the owner shall pay a fee in accordance with Section 35.70.

All other portions of Section 75.32 remain unchanged.

SECTION 4: That Section 114.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 114.05 OWNER'S OR PUBLIC TRANSIT PROGRAM OPERATOR'S LICENSE FEES. (TAXI)

No taxicab owner's license or public transit program operator's license shall be issued or continued in operation unless the holder thereof has paid an annual owner's license fee for the right to engage in the taxicab or public transit program business, and a subsequent fee each year for each vehicle operated under the owner's or program operator's license. License fees shall be for the calendar year, and shall be in addition to any other license fees or charges established by the proper authority, and applicable to the owner of the vehicle or vehicles under his or her operation and control. See Section 35.70 for permit fee information.

SECTION 5: That Section 114.08(B) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 114.08 APPLICATION FOR DRIVER'S LICENSE. (TAXI)

(B) Each applicant shall furnish a recent photograph, approximately three inches square, and fingerprints in duplicate. At the time the application is filed, the applicant shall have in his or her possession and show to the Board an Ohio driver license which is not revoked, and shall pay to the Board the fee as set forth in Section 35.70. Before approval is given by the Taxicab Review Board, the applicant shall provide a certificate from a physician licensed by the State of Ohio Medical Board certifying that in his or her opinion the applicant is not afflicted with any disease or infirmity which might make the applicant an unsafe or unsatisfactory driver.

All other portions of Section 114.08 remain unchanged.

SECTION 6: That Section 111.02(C) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 111.02 PERMIT APPLICATIONS. (SPECIAL EVENTS)

(C) *Fee.* See Section 35.70 for special events permit fee information.

All other portions of Section 111.02 remain unchanged.

SECTION 7: That Section 112.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 112.03 LICENSE ISSUANCE: FEE. (JUNK DEALERS)

The Mayor or such officer as he or she shall designate is authorized to grant a license to any reputable person, who is a resident of the city and a citizen of the United States, with an established place of business in the city, to engage in the business of a junk dealer for the purchase and sale of articles mentioned in this chapter. See Section 35.70 for permit fee information.

All other portions of Section 112.03 remain unchanged.

SECTION 8: That Section 113.04(C) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 113.04 LICENSE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.
(PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS)

(C) See Section 35.70 for permit fee information.

All other portions of Section 113.04 remain unchanged.

SECTION 9: That Section 115.02(E)(2)&(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 115.02 ADVERTISING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY. (BANNERS)

(E)(2) See Section 35.70 for installation and permit fee information.

Section (E)(3) is hereby removed as not necessary. All other portions of Section 115.02 remain unchanged.

SECTION 10: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH THE BOWLING GREEN POLICE PATROLMAN'S ASSOCIATION OPBA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, representatives of the City of Bowling Green and representatives of the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, have negotiated a contract, and

WHEREAS, the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, has ratified said contract;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to sign and enter into a contract with the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, said contract being on file in the Personnel Department of the City of Bowling Green.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that the prompt implementation of said contract is necessary in order to maintain continuity with the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, and in that manner protect the public health, safety, and welfare of our citizens.
