

RESOLUTION 04-2017-01

**AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND  
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR ODOR CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS  
AT THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, complaints have been received regarding odors from the Water Pollution Control Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing Septage Receiving Station and the ATAD Biofilter are the likely sources of the odor complaints; and

**WHEREAS**, the addition of an odor control system utilizing carbon filters can treat the odors and reduce the potential for odor complaints in the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 Water & Sewer Capital Improvement Fund budgeted for odor control improvements at the Water Pollution Control Facility; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Bowling Green Board of Public Utilities, a majority of its members thereto concurring, that the Utilities Director is authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for Odor Control Improvements at the Water Pollution Control Facility; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Bowling Green City Council is hereby respectfully requested to concur in the Board of Public Utilities action by granting the necessary legislative approval including three readings at the next Council meeting to expedite the installation of this project due to the public need.
