SECTION 5: That the Clerk of this Council is hereby directed to publish the full text of the proposed charter amendment, as set forth above, once a week for not less than 2 consecutive weeks in the Sentinel Tribune, published in the municipal corporation, with the first publication being at least fifteen (15) days prior to the election provided for herein, all in accordance with Section 9 of Article XVIII, Ohio Constitution, and Ohio Revised Code Section 731.211.

**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 7.01 OF THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN CONCERNING CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the question of the amendment of the Charter of the City of Bowling Green, to be effective January 1, 2019, so that as amended the same shall read as follows:

**SECTION 7.01 – CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION**

There shall be a Civil Service Commission appointed in accordance with and having the powers provided by general law for Civil Service Commissions in cities.

When a vacancy occurs in the entry level position of the Police or Fire Division to be filled by appointment, the Civil Service Commission shall certify to the appointing authority the names of the five (5) persons standing highest on the eligibility list for such position. The appointing officer shall appoint one of such persons to such position.

When a vacancy occurs in any other position of the classified service of the city to be filled by appointment or promotion, the Civil Service Commission shall certify to the appointing authority the names of the three (3) persons standing highest on the eligibility list for such position. The appointing officer shall appoint one of such persons to such position.

When compiling an eligibility list for entry level positions, a bonus credit of 10% of the passing test score shall be awarded to honorably discharged veterans of the United States military service.

The Civil Service Commission may prescribe rules and regulations for the management and hiring of employees of the City. In all other respects the Civil Service Commission shall be governed by the laws of Ohio applicable to cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the question of the amendment of the Charter of the City of Bowling Green, to be effective January 1, 2019, so that as amended the same shall read as follows:

SECTION 9.02 – AMENDMENT TO CHARTER

This Charter and any section thereof may be amended as provided by the Constitution of the State of Ohio, by submission of the proposed amendment or amendments to the electors of the city. If any such proposed amendment shall be approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, it shall become a part of this Charter, except that if 2 or more inconsistent proposed amendments on the same subject shall be submitted at the same election, only the one of such amendments receiving the highest number of affirmative votes, not less than a majority, shall become a part of the Charter.

At least once every ten years, a Charter Review Committee consisting of residents of the City of Bowling Green shall be appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by Council. At that time, the Committee so appointed shall review the Charter as well as Chapter 30 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the city, and make a report not more than 180 days after said appointment to the Mayor and City Council.

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby authorized to execute easement agreements to Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., for replacement of a natural gas lines in conjunction with the Columbia Gas Bowling Green Streetscape Project (project #18-0108203-00) and in substantial accordance with the exhibits attached hereto and made a part hereof.
