

**ADOPTING RIDER D - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
IN THE ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green owns and operates an electric distribution system for the benefit of its residents and customers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to encourage electric sales (kWh) growth which will lower the average cost of wholesale power purchases and benefit all customers; and

WHEREAS, the City can offer a financial discount to qualifying customers to encourage customers to increase their electric (kWh) usage; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Bowling Green Board of Public Utilities, a majority of its members thereto concurring, that Rider D - Economic Development shall be included in the Electric Rate Schedule, per the attached document, is hereby adopted July 23, 2018.
