

RESOLUTION 09-2018-01

AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) WITH
AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
R.I.C.E. PEAKING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the five diesel generators located at Substation #4 that were associated with the JV5 and JV2 project were sold to a third party and are no longer available for peak shaving to reduce power supply costs; and

WHEREAS, four of the JV generators have been removed from Substation #4 with the final generator set to be removed in mid 2019; and

WHEREAS, the last JV generator at Substation #4 provides emergency backup power for the Water Pollution Control facility and must be replaced prior to its removal in order to provide emergency backup power to the WPC; and

WHEREAS, AMP has offered a diesel generator project to the members that will lower annual power supply costs and provide emergency backup power for the WPC; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to utilize existing funds to pay for the project and avoid financing costs if possible; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bowling Green Board of Public Utilities, a majority of its members thereto concurring, that the Utilities Director is authorized to enter into an agreement with American Municipal Power (AMP) for a 2,700 kW diesel generator as part of the R.I.C.E. Peaking Project including using available Electric Revenue Funds to avoid financing costs if possible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bowling Green City Council is respectfully requested to concur in the Board of Public Utilities action by granting the necessary legislative approval.
