ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 33.01(N) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING SALARY SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 33.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 33.01 SALARY SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

(N) All non-temporary, non-bargaining full-time and part-time city employees (hourly and salaried), who were employed as current/active employees by the city on or before July 1, 2019 shall receive a 3.0% increase to their base pay (2080 or 2704 rate). The pay band maximums previously outlined in Section G of this ordinance are for hiring purposes only. If the 3.0% base rate increase results in an employee's base rate exceeding the established maximum, the employee will still be granted the full 3.0% base rate increase. This base pay increase shall be paid through the city's pay system on the next pay cycle following July 1, 2019. Temporary or other seasonal employees are not eligible to receive this payment. City employees, who are no longer employed by the city on July 1, 2019 will not be eligible to receive this payment. If the rate increase results in a pay rate that is less than the established minimum of the appropriate pay band, then the employee's pay rate will be increased in order that the rate of pay is at least equal to the established minimum rate of pay for the pay band.

All other portions of Section 33.01 remain unchanged.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law and/or as stated in each section.

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 33.03(A) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, RELATING TO PAY FOR SCHOOL POLICE, INTERNS, AND CIVIL INFRACTIONS HEARING OFFICER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 33.03(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 33.03 PAY SCALE ESTABLISHED FOR SCHOOL POLICE AND INTERNS, AND CIVIL INFRACTIONS HEARING OFFICER

- (A) School Police.
(1) \$12.81 for a morning crossing (start of school day) worked.
(2) \$12.81 for mid-day crossing worked (employees who cover mid-day crossings will be paid a maximum of \$12.81 regardless whether they cross children only at the end of the morning kindergarten session only at the start of the afternoon kindergarten session, or are required to cover both mid-day time periods).
(3) \$12.81 for afternoon crossing (end of school day) worked.

Employees working as School Police shall in no case be paid more than \$38.43 per day.

The crossing rates established above for School Police shall be effective August 1, 2019.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXCHANGE OF REAL ESTATE WITH THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a deed for property owned by the City of Bowling Green generally known as 1236 Conneaut Avenue, Bowling Green, Wood County, Ohio, to the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities, as said property is no longer necessary for any municipal purpose, and to accept a deed in exchange therefor from the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities for property generally known as 316 North Church Street, Bowling Green, Wood County, Ohio. The value of the property at 1236 Conneaut Avenue is \$39,000.00, and the value of the property at 316 N. Church Street is \$175,000.00, accordingly, the City's Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay the difference to the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities in the amount of \$136,000.00 at the time the real properties are exchanged.

## ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO SELL AND/OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF MATERIALS NOT NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to sell and/or otherwise dispose of oak wood harvested from trees that need to be removed in City Park in conjunction with the construction of the new City Park building.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that it is necessary to offer the wood for sale as soon as possible after it is harvested in order to optimize the condition of the wood, thereby protecting the public health, safety and well-being of the citizens.
