RESOLUTION HONORING DANIEL GORDON, MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO

WHEREAS, Daniel Gordon honorably and faithfully served the citizens of the City of Bowling Green as the First Ward Council Member from January 1, 2012 until October 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, during his time on Council, Mr. Gordon exhibited thoughtful judgment, purposeful determination, and earnest concern for his constituents; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gordon's abilities were demonstrated through his service as Chair of the Transportation and Safety Committee and the Community Improvement Committee and his service on the Parks and Recreation Committee; and

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 151.45(D) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO,
REGARDING STREETS AND SIDEWALKS**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 151.45(D) of the Codified Ordinances of
the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted as
follows:

SECTION 151.45 STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

(D) Sidewalks shall be provided on all residential and commercial lots,
except for industrial uses in a park setting as modified by § 151.38(B)(6)
where sidewalks are provided only on arterial and collector streets.
**Minimum sidewalks widths shall meet City of Bowling Green
Engineering specifications. Curb ramps shall be built at intersections
and shall be built to Public Rights-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines.**

SECTION 2: All other existing portions of Section 151.45 remain
unchanged.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time
permitted by law.
