RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE NATUREWORKS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program and/or the state of Ohio NatureWorks Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green seeks financial assistance from the NatureWorks Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to administer a grant to implement said program, and the Mayor is authorized to sign said agreement.

SECTION 2: The Council hereby certifies that the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, has the legal authority to apply for and accept an offer of grant funding.

SECTION 3: The City of Bowling Green agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Program.

SECTION 4: The Council hereby certifies that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF (A) PROPOSAL(S) AND/OR (AN) APPLICATION(S) WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR GRANTS THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA), AS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL TRANSIT LAWS, AS CODIFIED, 49 USC SECTION 5311, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR OTHER THAN URBANIZED AREAS AND FUNDS AVAILABLE FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT PROGRAM, EXECUTING A CONTRACT/GRANT FOR THE FY 2020 OHIO ELDERLY AND DISABLED TRANSIT FARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, AND 5339 AND/OR 5311 FUNDING FOR CAPITAL AND/OR OPERATING ASSISTANCE, AND EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UPON GRANT PROPOSAL(S) AND/OR APPLICATION APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a public transportation program;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of a proposal and/or application for assistance under 49 USC Section 5311 the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprise be used to the fullest extent possible in connection with this/these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOWLING GREEN CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file (a) proposal(s) and/or (an) application(s) on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects pursuant to 49 USC Section 5311 and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and submit (a) 5311 and/or 5339 application(s) on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program.

SECTION 3: The Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file with such proposals and/or applications and assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

SECTION 4: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal and/or application for the program of projects submitted to FTA.







ORDINANCE LEVYING A \$5.00 MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX AS AUTHORIZED BY OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby an annual license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads or highways pursuant to §4504.06, Ohio Revised Code for the purposes of paying the costs and expenses of enforcing and administering the tax provided for in this section; and to provide additional revenues for the purposes set forth in §4504.06, Ohio Revised Code; and to supplement revenue already available for such purposes.

Such tax shall be at the rate of \$5.00 per motor vehicle on each and every motor vehicle the district of registration of which, as defined in §4503.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, is in the City of Bowling Green, Ohio.

As used in this Ordinance, the term "motor vehicle" means and shall include vehicles within the definition of motor vehicle in the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: The tax imposed by this Ordinance shall apply to and be in effect for registrations beginning July 1, 2019, or at the earliest time legally authorized, and shall continue in effect and apply during each registration thereafter.

SECTION 3: The tax imposed by this Ordinance shall be paid to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio or to a Deputy Registrar at the time of application for registration of a motor vehicle is made pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: All monies derived from the tax herein before levied shall be used by the City of Bowling Green, Ohio for the purposes specified in this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: The Clerk of Council is directed to mail a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in Columbus, Ohio, prior to the July 1, 2019 effective date.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is to meet deadline dates for submission to the State, thereby protecting the well-being and safety of the citizens.
