## ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 33.23(B) & (E) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING MEDICAL, DENTAL AND VISION INSURANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 33.23(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

### SECTION 33.23 MEDICAL AND DENTAL INSURANCE.

(B) Effective July 1, 2006, part-time, non-temporary/ non-seasonal hourly city employees are eligible to participate in the city's group medical insurance plan if they are hired to work a minimum of 1,250 hours per calendar year. Non-temporary, salaried/exempt part-time personnel will be eligible to participate in the city's group medical insurance plan if they are hired based on their salary equating to at least 50% of the annual salary that a full-time salaried/exempt employee would receive who is similarly classified. Eligible part-time employees who elect participation in the city's group medical insurance shall pay 50% of the city's total monthly premium cost for medical insurance via payroll deduction. The city shall then pay the remaining 50% of the monthly medical insurance premium at the single, employee plus spouse, employee plus children, or family rates, depending upon the employee's eligibility. **Effective January 1, 2020, non-temporary/non-seasonal part-time hourly or salaried employees, who meet the works hours and/or salary eligibility criteria previously established, will be eligible to participate in the City's group dental and vision plans at their own expense. They must pay 100% of the dental and vision premiums.**

(E) Effective January 1, 2020, the group insurance pool of which the City is a member is offering voluntary vision coverage. This coverage will be offered to eligible employees effective January 1, 2020, but all participating full-time and eligible non-temporary/non-seasonal part-time employees, who meet the work hours and/or salary eligibility criteria outlined in Section (B) above, will be responsible for paying 100% of the premiums associated with participation.

SECTION 2: All other existing portions of Section 33.23 remain unchanged.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 76.23(C) & (D) AND SECTION 76.24 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING OPERATION OF METERS, COIN DEPOSIT, AND TIME MECHANISM & PARKING TIME LIMITS AND AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 35.70 REGARDING CITY FEES AND FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PARKING EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 76.23 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**SECTION 76.23 OPERATION OF METERS, COIN DEPOSIT, AND TIME MECHANISM**

(C) On application to the Safety Director and with advance payments of established rates to the Finance Director, parking permits in specified metered spaces shall be permitted.

(3) (a) Permits will only be issued for 13 weeks, 26 weeks, 39 weeks, or 52 weeks at a rate as established by 35.70. No reduction shall be made for holidays occurring within the permit period.

(D) Reserving of meters for a fee as established by 35.70 is arranged through the Police Division under the authority of the Safety Director. The reservation of a meter may not occur for more than 30 consecutive days. Extensions beyond 30 days will require approval of the Safety Director.

All other portions of Section 76.23 remain unchanged.

SECTION 2: That Section 76.24 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**SECTION 76.24 PARKING TIME LIMITS**

Each parking meter within the parking meter zones as set forth in §76.20 shall have the maximum allowable time affixed on the meter post. The maximum times shall be as follows:

- (A) Fifty cents (\$0.50) per hour, three-hour maximum parking. No person shall park a motor vehicle in a three-hour maximum meter space for a continuous time longer than three hours.
- (B) Fifty cents (\$0.50) per hour, ten-hour maximum parking;
- (C) Fifty cents (\$0.50) per hour, one-hour maximum parking. No person shall park a motor vehicle in a one-hour maximum meter space for a continuous time longer than one hour.
- (D) Vehicles parked in short-term, on-street parking spaces must move vehicle at least one city block every two hours.
- (E) Vehicles with a current and valid handicap placard parked in a designated handicap parking space within City-owned parking lots are free of charge.

SECTION 3: That Section 35.70 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**SECTION 35.70 CITY FEES AND FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES**

All other fees listed in Section 35.70 remain unchanged.

SECTION 4: That the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with IPS Group, LLC for parking equipment.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is to ensure accurate procedural adherence to Robert's Rules and to affirm Council's commitment to enforce parking regulations in downtown Bowling Green, thereby protecting the public health, safety and well-being of the citizens.
