RICHARD H. GORSUCH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

PURPOSE:

To establish an educational program encouraging high school students in AMP member communities to further their educations; and to create an awareness of careers in the municipal electric utility field.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

There are up to four (4) one-time scholarship awards of \$3,000 each.

AWARD DATES:

Applications must be received by the Director of Utilities for the City of Bowling Green, 304 North Church Street, no later than 4:30 PM, December 11, 2019.

ELIGIBILITY:

The following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants:

1. Applicant must be a student who is **either**, or whose parent or guardian is **either**:
 - a. An employee of an AMP member municipal electric system. For the purposes of this scholarship, an employee is defined as someone on the municipal electric system's payroll, or an employee or elected official who is in a position with the municipality to which the municipal electric system is subordinate; or
 - b. An employee of AMP.
2. Applicant must **either**:
 - a. Live with the parent or guardian outlined above; or
 - b. Live at another residence within the area in which that parent or guardian is employed.
3. The scholarship is offered **only** to an immediate member of the family (*child or ward*) of an AMP member municipal electric department employee or an AMP employee, or if the student them self is employed by AMP or the member municipal electric department.
4. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who has met all of the basic requirements for college or technical school entrance and has a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (B) or better on a 4.0 scale.
5. Applications must be type written and submitted on forms furnished by the City of Bowling Green. An electric version of the scholarship is available on the city's website at www.bgohio.org or by e-mail request to mmazey@bgohio.org
6. Each application form shall be submitted with:
 - A. An official grade transcript, showing the nominee's cumulative grade-point average based on a 4.0 scale for six semesters;
 - B. A type written description of personal achievements and participation in school and community activities;
7. To receive his or her scholarship award, a recipient must offer proof of enrollment in an accredited college, university or technical school for the next fall semester or quarter, unless an extension of time is granted. A time extension will be granted only if "just cause" is determined by the President of AMP. In the event that a student is unable to fulfill his/her enrollment obligations under this program, the award is forfeited and reassigned to another nominee by the President of AMP.

A check for the award will be written jointly to the recipient and the post-secondary school, or as circumstances dictate.

The City of Bowling Green will select one (1) nominee to represent the City of Bowling Green from all applications received for the Lyle B. Wright Scholarship Program

AWARD DATES:

City of Bowling Green applications must be received by the Director of Utilities for the City of Bowling Green, 304 North Church Street, no later than 4:30 PM, December 11, 2019.

RULES & ELIGIBILITY:

The following provisions will govern the acceptance of City of Bowling Green applicants:

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who has met all of the basic requirements for college or technical school entrance and has a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.
2. Applicant must be a student whose parents' or guardians' households receive electricity from the City of Bowling Green Electric Division.
3. A student who is an employee of an AMP member municipal electric department; members of the immediate family (child or ward) of an AMP member municipal electric department employee (see below) or members of the immediate family of an AMP employee are not eligible for the Lyle B. Wright Scholarship. (However, they may apply for the Richard H. Gorsuch Scholarship)
4. Applications must be typewritten or handwritten in ink and submitted on forms furnished by the City of Bowling Green. An electronic version of the scholarship is available on the city's website at www.bgohio.org or by e-mail request to mmazey@bgohio.org
5. Each City of Bowling Green application form shall be submitted with the following documents:
 - A. A **copy** of your official grade transcript, showing the applicant's cumulative grade-point average based on a 4.0 scale for six semesters.
 - B. A typewritten or handwritten description of personal achievements and participation in school and community activities;

These documents will be used to select one (1) City nominee to represent the City of Bowling Green for one of the \$3,000 Lyle B. Wright Scholarship awards.
