RESOLUTION SEEKING EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF CORONAVIRUS AID TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and all of its residents, have been hard hit by the coronavirus, experiencing a significant reduction in income tax receipts, and the likelihood of a severe reduction in enrollment at Bowling Green State University, which likely will result in a commensurate reduction in income tax receipts from our major employer; and

WHEREAS, assistance proposed by federal and state legislators to date, and especially with respect to the CARES Act, do not permit the direct payment to local governments of communities having a population of less than 500,000 people; and

WHEREAS, communities of every size in the State of Ohio will suffer the same effects of a financial crisis in a relative sense; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green relies on the collection of its income tax to provide nearly 60% of the funds necessary to provide for fire fighters, police officers, and essential services to our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green has been advised by the State of Ohio to expect a reduction of 20% to 40% in income tax funds collected as a result of the effect of the economic slowdown; and

WHEREAS, municipalities in the State of Ohio will be among the hardest hit as a result of the reliance upon municipal income taxes for providing services to our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green operates all of the municipal water, sewer and electric utilities in the community, placing an even greater burden on municipal budgets and the ability to provide for our citizens. Said services continue to be provided by the City in spite of the shutdown of industrial users and Bowling Green State University, the reduction in consumption, and the fact that many of our residents are unable to pay their bills at this time due to layoffs or furlough, although associated expenses in providing said utilities remain generally constant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green will not benefit from coronavirus relief funds made available so far, as neither Bowling Green nor Wood County meet the population thresholds established by the current relief programs as presently constituted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That with respect to future relief fund legislation, both the federal government and our state government are encouraged to allow for distribution of proposed local government aid to be made on a per person basis based upon the most recent decennial census, so that all local governments named receive funds commensurate with their population size, as all governments at every municipal level in Ohio are trying effectively and efficiently to mitigate the negative financial effects of the mandated stay at home order that has been suffered to date, and will be experienced in the future.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION 1: That upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the street name of Bay Harbor Court East is hereby changed for its entire length to East Bay Harbor Court, and additionally the street name of Bay Harbor Court West is hereby changed for its entire length to West Bay Harbor Court.

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY 40.586 ACRES OF LAND IN CENTER TOWNSHIP, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO FROM CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, PETITIONER

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain territory in Center Township was duly filed by the owners thereof, and

WHEREAS, the petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Wood County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation to the City of Bowling Green; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of proceedings in connection with the annexation with a map and petition required in connection therewith to the Clerk of City Council, who received the same on the 31st day of January, 2020; and

WHEREAS, 60 days from the date of the filing have now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition by the City of Bowling Green of the real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Wood County, which petition sought annexation to the City of Bowling Green of certain territory adjacent thereto and as fully described on the exhibits attached, was approved for annexation to the City by the Board of County Commissioners, and the same is hereby accepted. The certified transcript of the proceedings for annexation with an accurate map of the territory together with the petition for its annexation and other papers relating the proceedings thereto of the County Commissioners are all on file with the Clerk of Council, and have been for more than 60 days.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to make three (3) copies of this ordinance, to each of which shall be attached a copy of the map accompanying the petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners, and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The Clerk of Council shall then deliver one copy to the County Auditor, one copy to the County Recorder, and one copy to the Secretary of State, and shall file notice of this annexation with the Board of Elections within 60 days after it becomes effective, and the Clerk of Council shall do all other things required by law.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


