



FACE COVERING REQUIRED

Per City Ordinance:

All individuals within the City of Bowling Green shall wear a face covering over the individual's nose, mouth, and chin in accordance with the following:

- **When entering, exiting, waiting in line to enter, and while inside a place of business/government operated facility that is open to the public.**
- **Individuals 6+ years old**
- **When a restaurant/bar patron is not seated eating or drinking at his or her table or at the bar.**
- **In any public transportation vehicle such as a bus, taxi, or ride-sharing vehicle or any other vehicle for hire or at a transit stop or waiting area for any public transportation.**
- **In any outdoor space/place where or when at least 6 feet physical separation is not maintained from others who are not members of the same household.**
- **When an individual is not engaged in exercising in a gym or similar indoor facility.**

Individuals who cannot wear a face covering because of a medical condition, mental health condition, special needs, or developmental disability, or who are unable to remove the face covering without assistance, and individuals who should not wear face coverings under CDC guidance are exempted from this order.
