WHEREAS, fees for meters and taps are designed to cover the expense incurred by the City for materials, labor, and equipment for providing these services; and

WHEREAS, staff recently reviewed the fees and recommend a number of adjustments based on changes in expenses and labor costs; and


WHEREAS, Water Policy #3002, Section 4.(d) is also recommended to be revised to reflect the City's actual cost of providing service; now therefore

RESOLUTION 03-2021-03

AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE A REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CARTER PARK WATER TOWER

WHEREAS, funds were included in the 2021 Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund budget for engineering services for improvements to the Western Water Tower; and

WHEREAS, the recommended improvements from the 2017 inspection identified very similar work to be performed to Western and Carter Park Water Towers to paint, install safety equipment, and add water quality equipment; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended the improvements would provide a larger benefit to the Carter Park Water Tower to improve water quality and visibility to the public and I-75; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, a majority of the Bowling Green Board of Public Utilities, authorize the Utilities Director to advertise a Request for Qualifications and enter into a contract(s) for engineering services for improvements to the Carter Park Water Tower; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bowling Green City Council is requested to concur in the Board of Public Utilities action by granting legislative approval.
